Dr Jan Declercq

Jan Declercq graduated from Ghent University in 1976. He is a founding member and chairman of the Flemish Working Group for Dermatology. After taking courses at the European School for Advanced Veterinary Studies in Luxembourg, he obtained the Certificate in Veterinary Dermatology from the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons in 1995. From 1999 until 2017, he was a guest professor for dermatology at Ghent University. In addition, he founded a small animal practice in Marke-Kortrijk, where he primarily offers dermatology referrals and consultations. He is a member of the British Veterinary Dermatology Study Group and the European Society of Veterinary Dermatology as well as the American Academy of Veterinary Dermatology. In 2001, he received the Most Valuable Contributor Award from the Vetderm Listserve, and in 2004 from the International Society of Dermatopathology. In 2017, he received the Flanders Award, the honor from SAVAB (Professional Association of Flemish Veterinarians) for a Flemish veterinarian who has left an unforgettable mark on the Flemish veterinary landscape. He is the author of numerous publications, co-author of chapters in manuals, and a respected speaker at national and international conferences.


